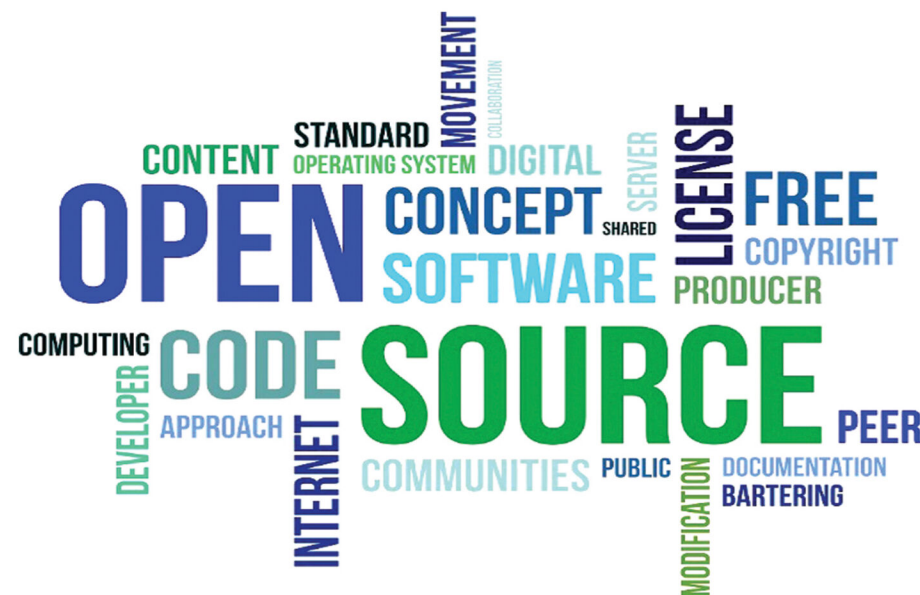

## ABOUT ST. ALOYSIUS COLLEGE

The college is situated in the Edathua Panchayat of the Kuttanad Taluk in the lake district of Alappuzha. It is the only temple of higher learning of the kind in the entire region of the one time granary of Kerala, Kuttanad. The college, though run by the catholic minority community (RCSC), admits students of all castes and creeds with due respect to different faiths and religious denominations.

## ABOUT KOHA

Koha is the first open source integrated library management system developed in 1999 by Katipo Communications New Zealand. koha is web based, multilingual integrated library system, designed to cater automation needs of medium to large libraries

It is customizable open source software (OSS). The competency of Koha supports international standards such as MARC 21, RFID, Z39.50, Web 2.0 etc. The software is fully customizable and includes all modules commonly used in any standard library management system.

- ♦ To promote open source library management system for better administration and management libraries.
